

BAND BOOSTERS SCHOLARSHIP

The Kenton City Schools Band Boosters award scholarships each year for students who have shown an appreciation for music, and have assisted in the music programs at Kenton City Schools.

APPLICATIONS

The Kenton Band Boosters will accept applications for the scholarships through the Kenton High School Guidance office, by February 15, each year.

QUALIFICATIONS

Qualified applicants will be attending an institute of higher learning. Preference will be given to applicants who are pursuing music education or performance degrees.

Two scholarships may be given each year in an amount up to \$250.00 each. Additional scholarships may be awarded in extraordinary circumstances determined by the scholarship committee.

Minimum qualifications include having been a member of the Kenton High School band for four years, having an accumulative Grade Point Average of 3.0, and performing services in furtherance of the Kenton Band program.

Students who transfer to Kenton High School during their high school years must still have four years of band in high school, provided band was offered at their prior school.

Students must provide proof of acceptance to an institute of higher learning as well as proof of intended major.

The scholarship will be paid directly to the institute of higher learning towards tuition or books or instrument fees.

The scholarship committee is appointed by the president of the Band Boosters no later than the January meeting each year.

NON COMPLIANCE

If a scholarship recipient for some reason does not enroll in the school indicated or does not complete the first year, then it is expected that the scholarship funds be returned to the Kenton Band Boosters.

The Band Boosters may not provide a scholarship if no qualified applicants are found.
